

REGULATIONS TO PROHIBIT PARKING AND PROVIDE
FOR THE TOWING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON NON-PUBLIC
STREETS, UNDER CERTAIN TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Designating certain private service streets as a "No Parking-Towing Zone" pursuant to Section 12-2403 of The Philadelphia Code, the area bounded generally by Twenty-second street, Twenty-fourth street, Park Towne place and Vine Street Expressway under certain conditions.

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 12-2403 of The Philadelphia Code pertaining to towing zones, the following private service streets are designated as "No Parking-Towing Zone":

- (a) The "U" shaped street entering and exiting on Park Towne place;
- (b) The street paralleling the Vine Street Expressway and Twenty-fourth street;
- (c) The connecting ramps between the streets referred to in subsection (a) and (b) above; except that parking shall be permitted within the specific locations described as follows:

(1) On the east side of the west leg of the "U"-shaped road starting at a point 100 feet from the intersection of the center lines of Park Towne place and the west leg of the "U"-shaped road and extending for a distance of 137 feet.

(2) On the west side of the east leg of the "U"-shaped road starting at a point 40 feet from the intersection of the center lines of Park Towne place and the east leg of the "U"-shaped road and extending for a distance of 19 feet.

(3) On the west side of the east leg of the "U"-shaped road starting at a point 140 feet from the intersection of the center lines of Park Towne place and the east leg of the "U"-shaped road and extending for a distance of 37 feet.

(4) On the north side of the south leg of the "U"-shaped road starting at a point 43 feet from the center line of the east leg of the "U"-shaped road and extending for a distance of 233.50 feet.

(5) On the east side of the ramp starting at a point 33.0 feet from the intersection of the center lines of the ramp and the south leg of the "U"-shaped road and extending for a distance of 122.24 feet.

Section 2. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to the penalties provided in Chapter 12-2400 of The Philadelphia Code.
