ALL RESIDENTS: 100 block of Tulpehocken St. (even side)

Effective Thursday, January 9, 2020 your trash and recycling collections will be picked up in front (curbside) of your property. The change is necessary due to the condition of the driveway including overgrown brush and low hanging wires that makes it difficult for trucks to navigate while driving.

By utilizing the following tips, you help keep the City clean:

Set out materials no earlier than 7:00 pm the night before collection day and no later than 7:00 AM the day of collection from April 1 through September 30. Trash and recycling should be set out between 5:00 PM the night before and 7:00 AM the day of collection at your regularly authorized pickup site from October 1 through March 31.

Set out for collection a maximum of either four (4) metal or other non-corrodible containers (no larger than 32 gallons) having a tight-fitting lid <u>or</u> eight (8) leak-proof bags (no larger than 30 inches x 37 inches).

Cardboard boxes may never be used as containers for trash or recycling. They should be flattened and stacked (no more than four feet long and two feet thick) and set out with recyclables.

Wood scraps and other loose items no more than four feet long and two feet thick should be loose, untied, and cut in pieces small enough to fit in a trash receptacle for set out.
